

The Council Chairperson

The Council Chairperson is elected at the Spring Conference in even-numbered years and serves a two (2)-year term. The Chairperson may serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms, for a maximum of four (4) years.

(Approved by the delegates in Rocklin, California, in June 2019)

The Council Chairperson should have prior experience serving NCCAA in any capacity, familiarity with the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts, and experience in other service positions. A minimum of ten (10) years of continuous sobriety is recommended.

The Council Chairperson should have sufficient time to conduct Council business, help present the two annual Conferences, and work closely with the Treasurer and Secretaries.

The Council Chairperson may delegate some or all responsibilities to one or more Secretaries or, when necessary, to another responsible A.A. member. The Chairperson remains fully accountable for all delegated functions. If the Chairperson cannot perform the Council's duties, one of the Secretaries will serve as Chairperson until a special election is held.
