Hi everyone!

I would like to thank both areas and Hospital and Institution for their continued support to NCCAA. My term is up in March 2018 so I wanted to start talking about my experience as NCCAA chair and what the last four years have entailed. I'll be sharing in our future Good News articles that experience so you may start thinking about if you would like to be chairperson. I've appreciated the communication for the last three years that we have had between both areas and hope that it will continue in the future. I'd like to update you all on the 2017 conferences celebrating our 70th Anniversary of the Northern California Council of Alcoholics Anonymous. As most of you know we have asked AAWS/ GSO and Grapevine to participate in our three conferences. At the Foster City Conference we started the 70th Anniversary with an Al-Anon speaker on Friday night at the 5:30 time slot and a Spanish speaker on Saturday night at the 5:30 time slot. The Spanish speaker spoke in Spanish and we had translation available into English. We will continue for the 2017 calendar to have those time slots available to both. In Sacramento June 9-11th, we will be having workshops about the Grapevine. I've talked with both Grapevine Area chairs asking them to help facilitate those workshops. Originally we had Ami B. coming to be our Friday night speaker but she had to cancel. I asked Joann L. (CNCA Delegate) to speak. The first workshop will show members how to write their stories for the grapevine which I asked CNIA to put together. The second workshop will show members how to record 7 minute audio's of their story to have on the website which I asked CNCA to put together. Members will be able to share their stories that day with everyone in the room. Also Joel C. (Pacific Regional Trustee) will be our Sunday morning speaker in Sacramento. In Lodi October 13-15th we will be having AAWS/GSO present. Greg T. (General Service office manager AAWS) will be our Sunday morning speaker. 

Updated NCCAA History Booklet Available!

As part of the celebration of NCCAA's 70th Anniversary, the NCCAA History Booklet has been updated to make the information more current and to reflect more recent history of NCCAA. The Northern California Council of Alcoholics Anonymous was an early pioneer in finding ways for our local fellowship to communicate and support each other. Alcoholics Anonymous co-founder, Bill W., was himself involved in the development of NCCAA and encouraged Northern California members to work together in organizing NCCAA events and conferences. The Hospital & Institution (H & I) Committee was becoming more organized at the same time, and H & I organizational meetings were often held in conjunction with NCCAA conferences this practice often still takes place today. Recently, there has been an increase in Al-Anon participation and Spanish-language members. Efforts have been made by our current officers, and Steering Committee to encourage this participation and there are now liaisons to the Steering Committee from Al-Anon and Spanish-language members. The officers of NCCAA encourage participation and serve the fellowship in determining the direction of NCCAA's future.
